Know About Low Temps In Your Greenhouse Before a Snowman Moves In!

It's that time of year again that ensuring your greenhouses stay warm enough is a high priority. The RWL11X2 and GHK12X2 both have an alarm function that can help alert you to any high or low temperature issues in your greenhouse.

Using the low alarm function, you can set the alarm to go off once the temperature in your house goes below your chosen temperature. With the help of a sensaphone or other like products, you will be alerted that the temperature in the house has gone too low.

To set the alarm for your GHK12X2 or RWL11X2:

- Press 'Menu' or 'Next' until ALM1 appears in the display.
- Press 'Enter' and 'Lo' will alternate with the low alarm temperature.
- Type in the desired temperature for the low alarm and press 'Enter'.
- 'HI' and the current high alarm temperature will alternate on the display.



• Type in the desired temperature for the high alarm and press 'Enter'.

• The display will now return to regular operation. If the controller is set for 2 zones, repeat steps for ALM2.
