Prevent Unintentional Firings With This Feature!

Your Bartlett controller has an option to require a two-key start of the kiln. This can ensure that the kiln isn't unintentionally fired if the "Start" key is bumped. The kiln would then need to be started by pressing "Start" then "Enter" before it would fire. This feature can be used on both the RTC1000 and the V6CF controller.

To activate the 2 key start:

- Press "Menu" then "4", "4", "3"
- "NOTC" should appear in the display
- Press "Menu" until 2KEY appears in the display
- Press "Enter"
- The display will either read "On" or "Off". To toggle between the two, press the 1 button.

- Once "On" is displayed, press Enter and the 2-key start is now activated.
