Learn How Our Timer/Mister Feature Could Work For You!

The timer/mister feature on your GHK12X2 and RWL11X2 can be a useful tool for running lights or mist irrigation. Once wired to your controller, you can set a simple timer to turn lights on at a designated time of day and run for a set length.

If you'd rather use it for mist irrigation, you can enter an on/off cycle for a programmed length of time, set to repeat after the set number of minutes has expired. Another option is to use the timer in conjunction with the alarm feature to run an energy curtain, but that calls for a separate newsletter for explanation.

Setting up the Timer is very simple:

- Press the Timer button until "TIMR" is displayed and press "Enter"
- "TIMR" and the start time will alternate flashing. (Remember the clock is in 24-hour format)
- Type in your desired start time and press "Enter"
- "HOLD" and the hold time (How long you want the timer to run) in hours and minutes will alternate flashing.
- Type in the desired hold time and press "Enter"
- "REPT" (Repeat) and "Off" or "On" will alternate flashing. Hours and minutes are separated by a dot on the display.

- Press the "Timer" key to toggle between "On" and "Off". When the desired setting is shown, press "Enter" and all information will be saved.
